

The campus offers an opportunity to explore and learn from a localised Southeast Asian perspective. Credit bearing units available to study abroad students include those that are focused on social issues, research and specialised business areas unique to this region:

- Malaysian Studies (School of Arts and Social Sciences): Learn more about the Malaysian history, socio-economy, politics and culture.
- Transformation in Southeast Asia (School of Arts and Social Sciences): Gain insight into the social and political issues of the Southeast Asian region.
- Business in Asia (School of Business): Investigate recent economic developments of selected Asian countries including the 1997 Asian financial crisis.
- Islamic Banking and Finance (School of Business): Learn from lecturers and researchers who are key opinion leaders in this field.
- Tropical Biology (School of Science): Gain access to the most diverse rainforests in the world situated in Borneo or turtle conservation sites at Perhentian Island.

The non-credit bearing Intercultural Enrichment Program or Malay Language course is also available to language and cultural enthusiasts who wish to broaden their horizons and learn a new language.


