- Applicants have undertaken the equivalent pre-requisite courses at their home institution (please note that pre-requisites are mandatory)
- The courses are available
- Approval is given by the relevant Faculty office
- Applicants to the National Institute of the Arts (NITA) are required to submit either a portfolio of their work, which may include slides, video or audio tapes, or completed compositions.
- Only students majoring in Law at their home institution will be considered for admission to Law courses at ANU

While every effort has been made to provide you with accurate course information, the University retains the right to amend course offerings and content.
