## English language pathways

Through its English Language Centre, SCU College offers English Language Programs (General English, English for Academic Purposes) to help prepare students for undergraduate and postgraduate courses at Southern Cross University.

The Centre's qualified English teachers are experienced in teaching English to international students. They understand the importance of creating a supportive, caring and comfortable learning environment and provide ongoing feedback to students as they progress while giving additional support where necessary. Students are also supported by experienced administrative staff to assist with accommodation, student sporting activities, computer access, and counselling referral.



### General English CRICOS 071758K

General English classes focus on communicative English which develops skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing at elementary, pre-intermediate, intermediate and upper-intermediate levels. Students may progress through these levels, and those who successfully complete General English at intermediate level can enter the English for Academic Purposes course. Courses run from five to 50 weeks in duration and include 20 hours face-to-face teaching and five hours independent self-study each week.

### English for Academic Purposes (EAP) CRICOS 064715B

EAP is designed to build on existing language abilities in reading, writing, speaking and listening. Students will be required to sit a free\*\* online **SCU Placement Test** or comparable test (see table below) to determine the number of weeks of English language studies required.

Successful completion of the EAP course leads to direct entry into SCU diplomas, associate degrees and degrees, subject to meeting academic requirements. Please note that some courses require a higher entry level of English.

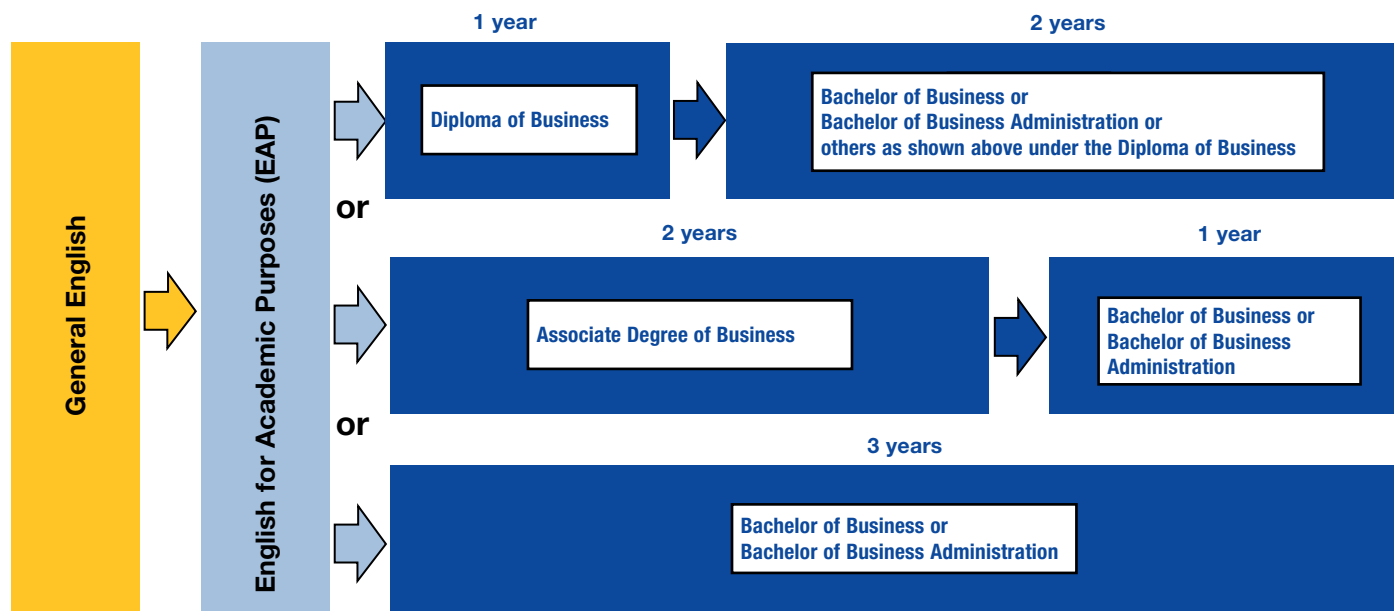
